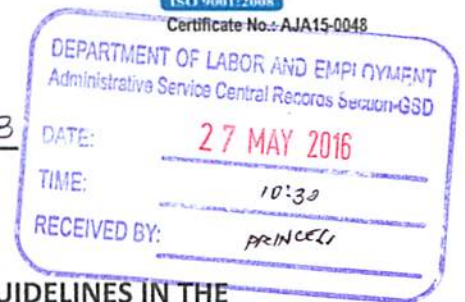

AMENDMENT OF DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 137-14, GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT INTEGRATED LIVELIHOOD AND EMERGENCY EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM (DILEEP)

In the interest of the service, and as provided under the General Appropriations Act (GAA) of 2016, Section 15. Beneficiaries, of DO No. 137-14, Series of 2014, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 9. Beneficiaries. – Pursuant to the Guiding Principles on Convergence...xxxxx

- a. Self-employed workers who are unable to earn sufficient income
- b. Marginalized and landless farmers
- c. Unpaid family workers
- d. Parents of child laborers
- e. Low-wage and seasonal workers
- f. Workers displaced or to be displaced as a result of natural and man-made disasters.

The program **may** also be extended to the following groups of disadvantaged workers with corresponding fund allocation of at least 1% of regional DILEEP funds for **each** sector to ensure access to the program funds.


1. Persons with Disabilities (PWDs)
2. Senior Citizens
3. Distressed returning OFWs
4. Indigenous people
5. Rebel Returnees
6. Victims of armed conflict

The Field Office (FO) in the region shall identify and recommend for approval...xxxxx.

In addition, the FO shall ensure that none of the child/children of livelihood ...xxxx
