Dear Secretary Andanar:

In compliance with the President's directive to operationalize the Constitutional mandate of the People's right to information thru the issuance of Executive Order No. 2, series of 2016, we are submitting herewith the DOLE's FOI 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Accomplishment Report for CY 2018, in which we received a total of one hundred nineteen (119) requests.

Out of 119 requests received, one hundred ten (110) or 92.4% of these requests were approved and nine (9) or 7.6% were denied as the information requested is not within the mandate of DOLE and/or under the exception list, per reports submitted by eleven (11) DOLE Offices, as shown below:

Also, some nineteen (19) DOLE offices<sup>1</sup> did not receive FOI request for the said quarter.

<sup>1</sup> Nineteen (19) DOLE Offices, namely, Administrative Service, Human Resource Development Management, Information and Publication Service, Bureau of Labor Relations, International Labor Affairs Bureau, DOLE-Cordillera Administrative Region, Regional Office Nos. 1,2, 4-B,7 ,8, 9, 10, and POLO-Tokyo, Kaohsiung, Taichung, Korea, Abu Dhabi and Dubai did not receive FOI request for the quarter.

The reasons for denying the requests are as follows:

1. The requests are included in the Inventory of Exceptions to the right to access per information to Executive Order No.02 (s. 2016);
2. Info not maintained: The requests are not being handled, maintained, or stored by the agency and/or another agency holds the information; and
3. Invalid request

Further, we have received additional ten (10) certifications from the following DOLE Offices, namely: Legal Service, Information and Publication Service, Human Resource Development Service, Bureau of Labor Relations, National Reintegration Center for OFWs, DOLE-National Capital Region, DOLE Regional Offices 7, 8, 9 and 10 saying that they did not receive FOI request for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of CY 2018.

We are also submitting the attached FOI Revised Registry Sheets of all FOI Requests received by the Department and the Summary of the Status of Processed Requests for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter.

We hope you will find this submission in order.
