DECLARING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR LOTS 1 AND 2 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE'S PROJECT "PROVISION OF COURIER SERVICES (DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL) FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR IN THE DOLE - CENTRAL OFFICE" A FAILURE

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) advertised the Invitation to Bid for the abovementioned project with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of ₱2,870,999.00 in the Philippine Government E-Procurement System (PhilGEPS), DOLE Website and conspicuous places at the DOLE's premises from 16 November 2020 to 08 December 2020;

WHEREAS, said project is included in the Indicative FY 2021 Indicative Annual Procurement Plan of the Department;

WHEREAS, the Pre-bid Conference scheduled on 24 November 2020 was attended by two bidders namely: (1) Raf International Forwarding Phils., Inc. and (2) Mailtag Ortigas Corporation;

WHEREAS, in response to the advertisement, two (2) bidders namely: (1) Raf International Forwarding Phils., Inc. and (2) Mailtag Ortigas Corporation purchased the bidding documents from the DOLE Bids and Awards Committee (DOLE BAC) Secretariat from 24 November 2020 to 01 December 2020;

WHEREAS, the submission and opening of bids scheduled on 08 December 2020 and likewise moved on 09 December 2020 was attended by two bidders namely: (1) Raf International Forwarding Phils., Inc. and (2) Mailtag Ortigas Corporation. Said bidders submitted their technical and financial envelopes. After opening their technical proposals and conduct of preliminary examination, Raf International Forwarding Phils., Inc. was rated as "passed" hence, the BAC opened its financial envelope which was also rated as "passed", while Mailtag Ortigas Corporation was rated as "failed" in view of its non-compliance with Section II-ITB Clause 20 of the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, based on the evaluation of the bids conducted by the DOLE-BAC Technical Working Group, Raf International Forwarding Phils., Inc. complied with the mandatory minimum specifications of the said project which was presented during the BAC meeting on 10 December 2020, Raf International Forwarding Phils., Inc. was declared as the Single Calculated Bidder per BAC Resolution No. 139, Series of 2020;

WHEREAS, on 14 December 2020, the BAC-TWG requested for the extension of post-qualification due to client verification;

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by Raf International Forwarding Phils., Inc., it was found out that the bid failed to comply with the technical requirements specified in the bidding documents for the said project;


NOW, THEREFORE, We, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:


- a. To post-disqualify Raf International Forwarding Phils., Inc. due to non-compliance with the technical requirements specified in the bidding documents for the said project
- b. To declare the competitive bidding a **“failure”** in view of the post-disqualification of the bidder;
- c. To recommend that a re-bidding be conducted; and
- d. To recommend for approval by the DOLE Undersecretary the foregoing findings.


