**DECLARING PETRON CORPORATION AS THE SINGLE CALCULATED  
AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER FOR THE PROJECT "PROCUREMENT OF  
FUEL (GASOLINE AND DIESEL) AND OIL/LUBRICANT THROUGH FLEET  
CARD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE)  
MOTOR VEHICLES FOR ONE (1) YEAR"**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) advertised the Invitation to Bid for the above-mentioned project with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of ₱2,295,000.00 in the Philippine Government E-Procurement System (PhilGEPS), DOLE website, and conspicuous places at the DOLE's premises from 24 December 2020 to 19 January 2021;

**WHEREAS**, said project is included in the approved Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Indicative Annual Procurement Plan of the Department;

**WHEREAS**, only Petron Corporation attended the Pre-bid Conference scheduled on 05 January 2021;

**WHEREAS**, Supplemental /Bid Bulletin No. 01, Series of 2021 to clarify or amend some provisions originally indicated in the Bidding Documents specifically on the Terms of Reference, General Conditions was issued to the bidders;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the advertisement, two (2) bidders namely: 1) Pilipinas Shell Petroleum Corporation, and 2) Petron Corporation purchased the bidding documents from the DOLE Bids and Awards Committee (DOLE BAC) Secretariat from 15 to 19 January 2021;

**WHEREAS**, on the Submission and Opening of Bids scheduled on 19 January 2021, only Petron Corporation attended. Two Bidders, namely: 1) Pilipinas Shell Petroleum Corporation, and 2) Petron Corporation submitted their technical

and financial envelopes. After the preliminary examination, the eligibility and technical requirements of Petron Corporation was rated as “**passed**” while Pilipinas Shell Petroleum Corporation was rated as “**failed**” due to non- submission of Audited Financial Statement stamped received by the BIR. Hence, the BAC - Technical Working Group (BAC-TWG) opened the financial envelope of Petron Corporation which was likewise found to be compliant and recommended for bid evaluation;

**WHEREAS**, based on the evaluation of the bids conducted by the DOLE BAC Technical Working Group on 19 February 2021, Petron Corporation was declared as the Single Calculated Bidder per BAC Resolution No. 009, Series of 2021 for the project “**Procurement of Fuel (Gasoline and Diesel) and Oil/Lubricant Through Fleet Card of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Motor Vehicles for One (1) Year**”;

**WHEREAS**, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by **Petron Corporation** its bid has been found to be responsive;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, We, the members of the DOLE Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- a. To declare **Petron Corporation** as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder for the project “**Procurement of Fuel (Gasoline and Diesel) and Oil/Lubricant Through Fleet Card of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Motor Vehicles for One (1) Year**”;
- b. To award the “**Procurement of Fuel (Gasoline and Diesel) and Oil/Lubricant Through Fleet Card of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Motor Vehicles for One (1) Year**” to **Petron Corporation**; and
- c. To recommend for approval by the DOLE Secretary the foregoing findings

**RESOLVED**, at the DOLE Main Building, Intramuros, Manila, this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of February 2021.


