CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this ____ day of OCT 21 2021, 2021 between the **DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE)**, with office address at DOLE Main Building, Muralla Wing cor. General Luna Street, Intramuros, Manila, represented by **UNDERSECRETARY RENATO L. EBARLE**, hereinafter called the “**DOLE**” and **COVER AND PAGES CORPORATION** with office address at 2763 Silang Street, Sta. Ana, Manila, represented by its Account Executive, **MS. MELANIE F. FERNANDO**, hereinafter called the “**SUPPLIER**”.

WHEREAS, the DOLE invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, viz., “**Printing of Coffee Table Book for the 65th Anniversary of the Bureau of Labor Relations**” and the DOLE has accepted a total Bid for **Three Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos only (₱364,500.00)** hereinafter called the “**Contract Price**”.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:

- i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications and Supplemental/Bulletin; and
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract;
- ii. Winning bidder’s bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder’s bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder’s response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity’s bid evaluation;

- iii. Performance Security;
- iv. Notice of Award of Contract, and the Bidder’s conforme thereto; and
- v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. **Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**

3. In consideration for the sum of **Three Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos only (₱364,500.00)** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **Cover and Pages Corporation** agrees to print 250 copies of coffee table book for the 65th Anniversary of the Bureau of Labor Relations in accordance with its Bid.
4. The DOLE agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.

IN WITNESS whereof the parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be executed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines on the day and year first above written.




