**DECLARING A FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE PROJECT “ENGAGEMENT OF TRAINING INSTITUTION/PROVIDER FOR THE CONDUCT OF ONLINE TRAININGS ON ISO 9001:2015 QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (QMS) FOR CY 2022”**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) advertised the Invitation to Bid for the competitive bidding of the project “Engagement of Training Institution/Provider for the Conduct of Online Trainings on ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management System (QMS) for CY 2022” with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of ₱452,000.00 in the Philippine Government E-Procurement System (PhilGEPS), DOLE website, and conspicuous places at the DOLE’s premises from 01 December to 21 December 2021;

**WHEREAS**, said project is included in the approved Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Indicative Annual Procurement Plan of the Department;

**WHEREAS**, the Pre-bid Conference via zoom platform originally scheduled on 07 December 2021 has been moved on 09 December 2021 and was attended only by JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the advertisement, only JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy purchased the bidding documents from the DOLE Bids and Awards Committee (DOLE BAC) Secretariat;

**WHEREAS**, the submission and opening of bids scheduled on 21 December 2021, only JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy attended. Said bidder submitted its technical and financial envelopes. After the preliminary examination, the eligibility and technical requirements of the bidder was rated as “**passed**”. Hence, the BAC - Technical Working Group (BAC-TWG) opened the financial envelope which was likewise found to be compliant and recommended for bid evaluation;

**WHEREAS**, based on the evaluation of the bids conducted by the BAC-TWG on 28 December 2021, JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy was declared as the Single Calculated Bidder per BAC Resolution No. 173, Series of 2021 for the project “**Engagement of Training Institution/Provider for the Conduct of Online Trainings on ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management System (QMS) for CY 2022**”;

**WHEREAS**, on 04 January 2022, the BAC Secretariat sent a notice to JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy, requesting for submission of post-qualification documents;

**WHEREAS**, JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy failed to submit its renewed Mayor's Permit or Official Receipt as proof of its pending application for renewal of its mayor's permit within five (5) calendar days from its receipt of the notice from the BAC that it has been declared as the Lowest Calculated Bid claiming that the LGU of San Carlos City, Pangasinan gave them a schedule date for the application of the Renewal/Updated Mayor's Permit on 24 January 2022 onwards;

**WHEREAS**, the Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) of JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy per re-computation resulted in negative Two Hundred Forty Two Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Three Pesos and 65/100 Only (-P242,623.65) which is lower than the ABC of P452,000.00. RA 9184 provides that the computation of a prospective bidder's NFCC **must be equal or higher than the ABC** to be bid;

**WHEREAS**, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy its bid has been found to be non-responsive due to non-submission of 2022 Mayor's Permit and Insufficient NFCC;

**WHEREAS**, on 24 January 2022, the BAC Secretariat issue a Notice of Post-Disqualification to JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environmental Consultancy;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, we, the members of the DOLE BAC, by virtue of the powers vested on us by law, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- a. To declare the bidding a "failure" due to the Post-Disqualification of JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environmental Consultancy for the project "Engagement of Training Institution/Provider for the Conduct of Online Trainings on ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management System (QMS) for CY 2022";
- b. To recommend that a re-bidding be conducted; and
- c. To recommend for approval by the DOLE Undersecretary the foregoing findings
