RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT OF THE PROJECT “PRINTING OF TEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR (10, 294) PADS OF DOLE VERIFICATION FEE OFFICIAL RECEIPTS FOR THE PHILIPPINE OVERSEAS LABOR OFFICES” TO NATIONAL PRINTING OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), thru the International Labor Affairs Bureau (ILAB), requisitioned for the printing of ten thousand two hundred ninety-four (10,294) pads of DOLE Verification Fee Official Receipts (DOLE Form VF-02) for the Philippine Overseas Labor Offices (POLOs) to be used in the collection of verification fees with an Approved Budget for the Contract of ₱3,499,960.00;

WHEREAS, said project is considered as accountable form of DOLE which is included in the Indicative FY 2022 Annual Procurement Plan of the Department;

WHEREAS, the BAC recommended Negotiated Procurement – Agency-to-Agency as the method of procurement to be adopted for the above-mentioned project as per approved BAC Resolution No. 101, Series of 2021;

WHEREAS, Appendix 20 - Guidelines on the Procurement of Printing Services of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, states:

“xxx Printing of Accountable Forms Sensitive High Quality/Volume Requirements shall only be undertaken by the Recognized Government Printers (RGPs), namely: Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas, National Printing Office, and APO Production Unit, Inc.”

WHEREAS, ILAB conducted a market study to determine which among the RGPs is most capable in performing the printing service in the most advantageous terms for the DOLE – ILAB;

WHEREAS, on 29 November 2021, Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas sent a letter stating that they cannot provide the quotation since the current production capacity of their Department is dedicated for the production of banknotes and judicial forms;

WHEREAS, APO Production Unit, Inc. and National Printing Office submitted a quotation stating that they are ready to undertake the printing requirements of the ILAB;

WHEREAS, the BAC-Technical Working Group (TWG) in its Abstract of Price Quotations examined and evaluated the bid proposals APO Production Unit, Inc. and National Printing Office, to wit:

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing evaluation, the bid proposal of National Printing Office submitted the lowest bid price for the above-mentioned project;

WHEREAS, NPO submitted a certification that they will comply with all the conditions of the printing requirements of the project;



- a) To engage the services of the National Printing Office (NPO) for the project "Printing of Ten Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Four (10,294) Pads of DOLE Verification Fee Official Receipts (DOLE Form VF-02) for the Philippine Overseas Labor Offices (POLOs) at a contract price of **₱2,161,740.00**; and
- b) To recommend for approval by the Undersecretary of the foregoing findings.


