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GUIDELINES ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF COVID-19 VACCINE BOOSTER DOSES FOR EMPLOYEES IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR

In support of the National Government's goal to ensure economic recovery amidst the pandemic and in view of the lower restrictive measures and Alert Level Classification in effect throughout the country, the following guidelines are hereby issued:

I. COVERAGE AND PURPOSE

This Advisory shall apply to all employers in the private sector, including economic zone locators, in administering COVID-19 booster doses for their employees, service contractors, suppliers, customers, family members of their employees, and neighboring communities.

II. PLACE OF ADMINISTRATION

The booster doses may be administered in worksites utilizing the company's occupational safety and health services.

III. VACCINATION TEAM/S

Employers may constitute their existing Occupational Safety and Health Committee as their vaccination team. The vaccination team should include a company nurse and a physician.

Duly constituted vaccination teams shall be capacitated by the National Vaccination Operations Center/ Regional Vaccination Operations Centers (NVOC/ RVOCs).

IV. PROVISION OF RESOURCES


Qualified employers shall be provided with available resources for administering the booster doses through the NVOC/RVOCs. The resources include COVID-19 vaccines, syringes, vaccine carriers, and additional vaccination teams at no cost to the employer.

V. SCHEDULE OF VACCINATION ACTIVITIES

Employers are highly encouraged to adjust their vaccination schedules to suit their operations and accommodate more vaccinees (e.g., Bakuna Night, Bakuna Sabado, among others).

Be guided accordingly.
