DECLARING AREZA MOTOR SALES AS THE SINGLE CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER FOR THE PROJECT "SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF BRAND-NEW AMBULANCE TYPE 1 FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE OFW HOSPITAL AND DIAGNOSTIC CENTER" (NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-TWO FAILED BIDDINGS)

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) advertised the Invitation to Bid for the abovementioned project with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of ₱1,800,000.00 in the Philippine Government E-Procurement System (PhilGEPS), DOLE Website and conspicuous places at the DOLE's premises from 25 January 2022 to 14 February 2022;

WHEREAS, said project is included in the FY 2022 Annual Procurement Plan of the Department;

WHEREAS, the DOLE Special Bids and Awards Committee (SBAC), through SBAC Resolution No. 01, Series of 2022, declared the competitive bidding for the "Supply and Delivery of Brand-New Ambulance Type 1 for the Procurement of Hospital Equipment for the OFW Hospital and Diagnostic Center" as "**failed**" and recommended that a re-bidding be conducted.

WHEREAS, no prospective bidders attended the Pre-Bid Conference scheduled on 02 February 2022;

WHEREAS, in response to the advertisement, no prospective bidder purchased the bidding documents from the DOLE SBAC Secretariat from 25 January 2022 to 14 February 2022;

WHEREAS, no prospective bidder attended the submission and opening of bids scheduled on 14 February 2022;

WHEREAS, on 14 February 2022, the DOLE SBAC, through SBAC Resolution No. 03, Series of 2022, declared the re-bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Brand-New Ambulance Type 1 for the Procurement of Hospital Equipment for the OFW Hospital and Diagnostic Center as "**failed**" and recommended that a Negotiated Procurement through Two-Failed Biddings be conducted;

WHEREAS, the Negotiations with bidders which was scheduled on 22 February 2022 was attended by three (3) prospective bidders, namely: (1) SFM Sales Corporation, (2) Toyota Pasong Tamo and (3) Areza Motor Sales;

WHEREAS, Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 01, Series of 2022 to clarify or amend some provisions originally indicated in the Bidding Documents specifically on Section VII. Technical Specifications was issued to bidders on 23 February 2022;

WHEREAS, after the mandatory review of the terms and conditions of the project, the SBAC-Technical Working Group (TWG) recommended to increase the ABC to Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) and decrease the payload (weight capacity) to at least One Thousand Eighty Kilograms (1080 kgs);

WHEREAS, the submission of Best and Final Offer was advertised at PhilGEPS from 19 to 24 March 2022;

WHEREAS, during the submission and opening of bids scheduled on 24 March 2022, AREZA MOTOR SALES submitted its technical and financial envelopes. After the conduct of preliminary examination, the technical proposal of AREZA MOTOR SALES was rated as “passed”. Hence, the SBAC opened the financial envelope of AREZA MOTOR SALES which was also rated as “passed”;

WHEREAS, the SBAC – TWG, in its bid evaluation report dated 25 March 2022 as duly concurred by the members of the SBAC, examined and evaluated the bid proposal of AREZA MOTOR SALES as follows:

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing evaluation by the SBAC-TWG, AREZA MOTOR SALES complied with the mandatory minimum specifications of the said project;

WHEREAS, the SBAC – TWG, in its Post – Qualification Report dated 28 March 2022, verified, validated and ascertained all statements made and documents submitted as required for the Negotiated Procurement of two-failed biddings and were rated as “responsive”;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, We, the members of the Special Bids and Awards Committee, in accordance with Annex “H”, V (D) (1) of the IRR of R.A. No. 9184, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby **RESOLVED** that the bid of **AREZA MOTOR SALES** be declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid for the project Supply and Delivery of Brand-New Ambulance Type 1 for the Procurement of Hospital Equipment for the OFW Hospital and Diagnostic Center and thus **recommended for Award of the Contract**. The Award of the Contract shall be made in accordance with Section IV (L) of Annex “H” of the Revised IRR of R.A. No. 9184.






