RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH DIRECT CONTRACTING TO CD TECHNOLOGIES ASIA, INC. THE PROJECT "SUBSCRIPTION TO THE ONLINE LAW AND JURISPRUDENCE LIBRARY OF CD ASIA FOR TWELVE (12) MONTHS"

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), through the Bureau of Labor Relations (BLR), requisitioned for the project "Subscription to the Online Law and Jurisprudence Library of CD Asia for Twelve (12) Months" for the regular 30 Mediator Arbiters, 2 Mediator-Arbiters Designates including the BLR Director with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of ₱221,760.00;

WHEREAS, Bureau of Labor Relations intend to engage CD Technologies Asia, Inc. (CD Asia).

WHEREAS, CD Technologies Asia, Inc., issued a certification that there is no sub-dealer or agent for the electronic legal publications and that CD Asia is the sole and exclusive distributor thereof; that it is the creator, publisher and copyright owner of the electronic legal publications on CD-ROM, DVD-ROM and On-line (www.cdasiaonline.com); that it has the sole and exclusive authority to use, or issue any license for the use of, any of the electronic legal publications, the contents, or any portion, thereof, as programmed and engineered, for any purpose, including, but not limited to, the creation of new publications and customized databases;

WHEREAS, the DOLE – Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) declared Direct Contracting as an alternative mode of procurement for the above-mentioned project per approved BAC Resolution No. 140, Series of 2022.

WHEREAS, the DOLE – BAC sent the Request for Quotation to CD Technologies Asia, Inc. for the project “Subscription to the Online Law and Jurisprudence Library of CD Asia for Twelve (12) Months”;

WHEREAS, Bureau of Labor Relations conducted a negotiation with CD Technologies Asia, Inc. on the terms and conditions of the contract;

WHEREAS, on 01 September 2022, CD Technologies Asia, Inc. submitted its post-qualification requirements;

WHEREAS, the DOLE – BAC, based on the result of careful examination, validation and verification of all the documents submitted, found CD Technologies Asia, Inc., to be responsive and eligible;


NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, by virtue of the powers vested on us by law, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:


- a. To award the project “**Subscription to the Online Law and Jurisprudence Library of CD Asia for Twelve (12) Months**” at a contract price of **₱221,760.00** to CD Technologies Asia, Inc.; and
- b. To recommend for approval by the DOLE Undersecretary the foregoing findings.


